Monitoring COSEGO – Safety Committee

Safety within an ANSP's jurisdiction is the responsibility of the CEO and Board. To that end, ENAIRe implements a high-level Safety Committee (COSEGO), composed of the members of the Board of Directors, that meets fortnightly so that the Board is fully aware and involved in the company's critical safety strengths and weaknesses.

Safety Culture promotion at the highest level within the organization.



Definition of actions for safety improvement, to be included in the Safety Plan.



Strategic decision-making based on safety information.



Follow-up of the Safety Plan actions.



Monitoring and follow-up of ENAIREs safety performance.



Monitoring and management of commitments with the Spanish NSA – AESA.



Presentation, management and tracking of high severity safety occurrences and derived mitigation measures.



Preparation and follow-up of safety assessments associated to relevant changes in the ANS.
