

Scope and timetable of the Feasibility Study

- [1] **Baltic FAB Feasibility Study** – evaluation of the potential of the Baltic FAB Initiative (PL + LT) – **October 2010**
- [2] **Baltic FAB Implementation Plan** - proposal for an implementation action plan – **March 2011**
- [3] **Initial Baltic FAB Development Study** – evaluation of the potential regional scenarios concerning the Baltic FAB (cooperation with neighbouring FABs/ANSPs) – **June 2011**
- [4] **Final Baltic FAB Development Study** – in-depth evaluation of three selected scenarios – **September 2011**

Structure of BALTIC FAB Programme





BALTIC FAB Implementation Plan





Baltic FAB Safety Roadmap up to 2012

- Review existing safety policies and plans (including State and ANSP Safety Programmes) to identify similarities and differences)
- Review safety indicators and targets, and develop a plan to work towards harmonisation
- Produce Part A of FAB safety case (Safety Management)
- Create FAB Safety Committee and agree terms of reference (structure, scope and responsibility)



Baltic FAB Safety Roadmap up to 2012

- Agree safety case methodology, including risk classification scheme, and relationship of FAB safety case to ANSP safety cases
- Review operational concept and assumptions, and develop safety case focusing on operational changes
- Identify key mitigations and transition safety case
- Produce Part B of FAB safety case (Functional/operational safety case)



Next actions

According to COMMISSION REGULATION (EU) No 176/2011 of 24 February 2011 PART II Requirements of Article 9a(2) of Regulation (EC) No 550/2004 preparation of :

- description of the arrangements dealing with accident and incident investigation and plans on how to address safety data collection, analysis and exchange;
- risk assessment and mitigation documentation before introducing operational changes resulting from the establishment of the functional airspace block.
