Accountabilities and Responsibilities – specified

Users of Psychoactive Substances – Withdrawal mandated

Engineering & Technical Staff performing safety related tasks – Detailed requirements

Generic Safety Requirements – Covering all ATM Service Personnel performing safety related tasks





