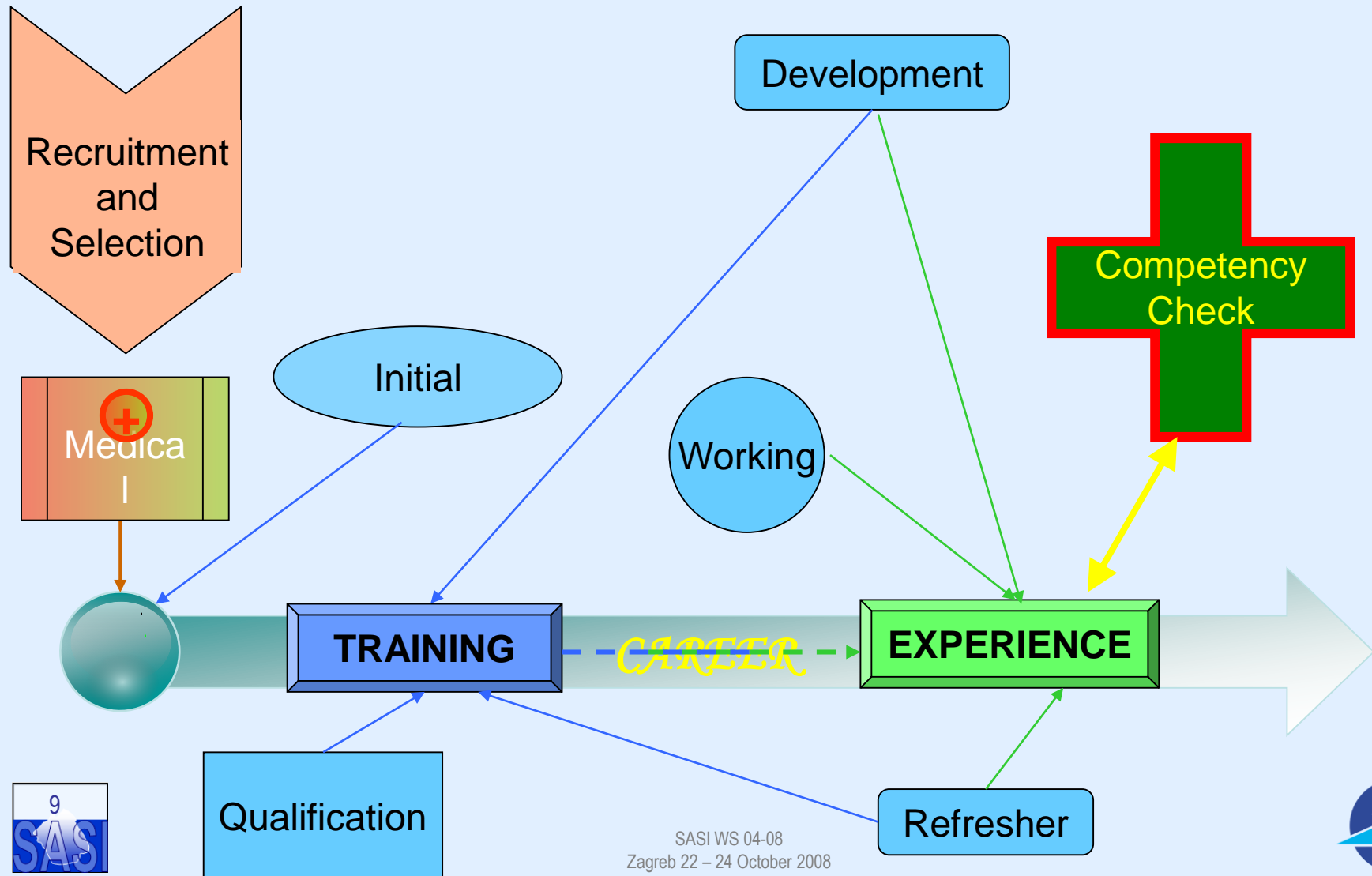
ATCOs

- Military providing ATS to Civil and Military traffic in mixed civil-military environment

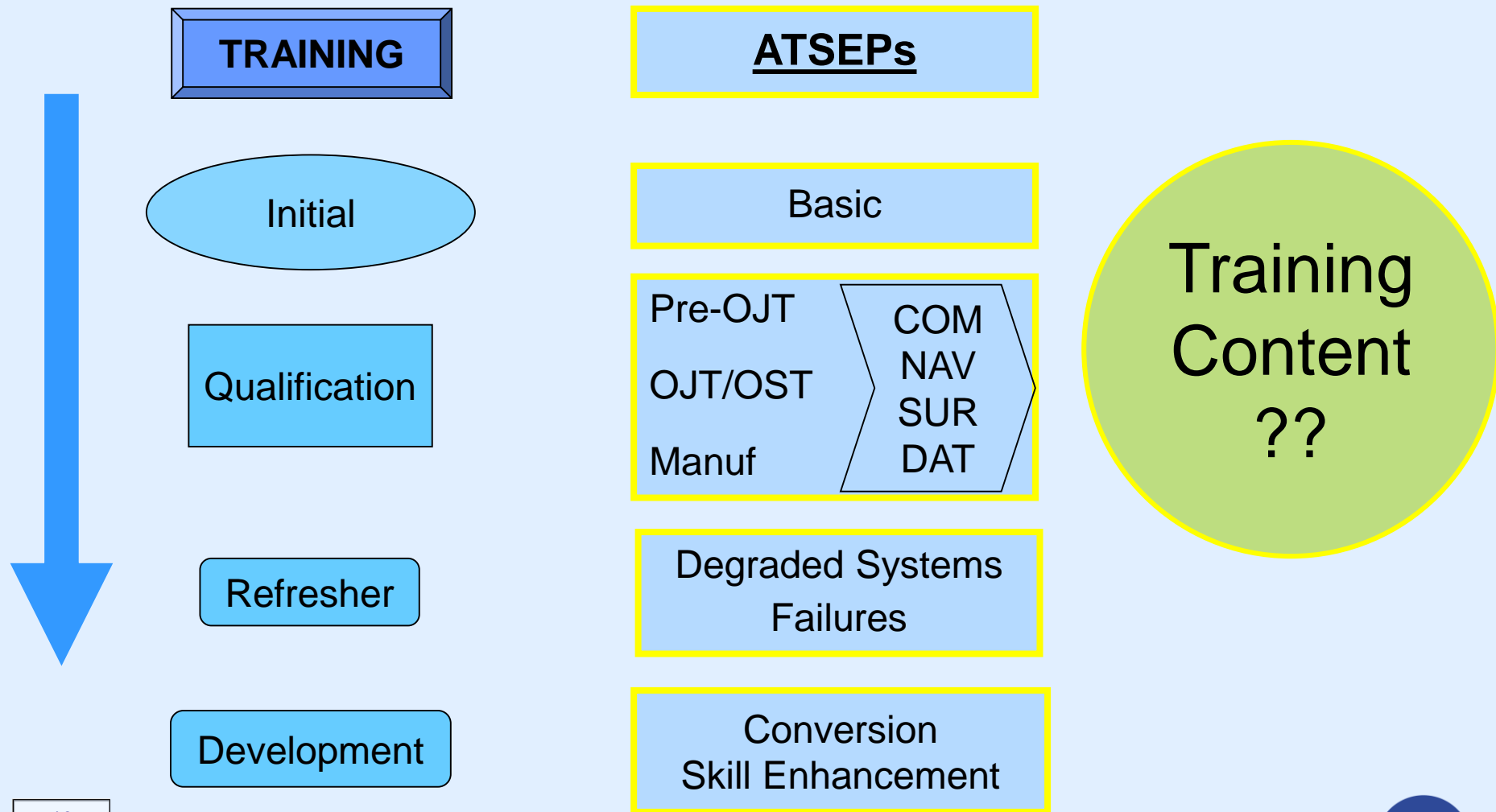
ATSEPs
