SASI WS 04-08 Day 1 Wednesday 22nd 1/2

- ESARR 5 - a compromise
- Designated Authority might not be the same as NSA
- *Operating Organisation - Any organisation that fall within the jurisdiction of the National ATM safety regulatory body and is responsible for the provision of engineering and technical services supporting ATM services*
- Other organisation can be covered by External Services part of SMS to ensure, via contract, that personnel providing service are compliant
- In principle processes for ATCOs can be **ADAPTED** to ATSEPs
- Harmonisation is possible but only up to a certain level due to local constraints

- ✓ No specific requirement but requirement exists for records so it is logical to use this DB
- ✓ Possible benefits but only after adaptation
- ✓ Could be one of the tools requested during Issue Analysis

SASI WS 04-08 Day 3 Friday 24th 2/2

- Open Discussion

- ✓ Lots of Guidance material and Information available but there seems to be a lack of will to issue regulations,
- ✓ Überlingen had shown that ATSEPs could contribute significantly to an accident,
- ✓ ATCO Competency Assessment (CA) processes need **adaptation** before being used for ATSEP CA,
- ✓ Request for a template for ATSEP Competency but EUROCONTROL can only provide generic guidelines. Each State then has to make its own study and adapt the generic template,
- ✓ Request for a list of ATSEP Training Institutions
- ✓ Need to emphasise reporting to ATSEPs,
- ✓ CA for military ATSEPs – how to do it?
