

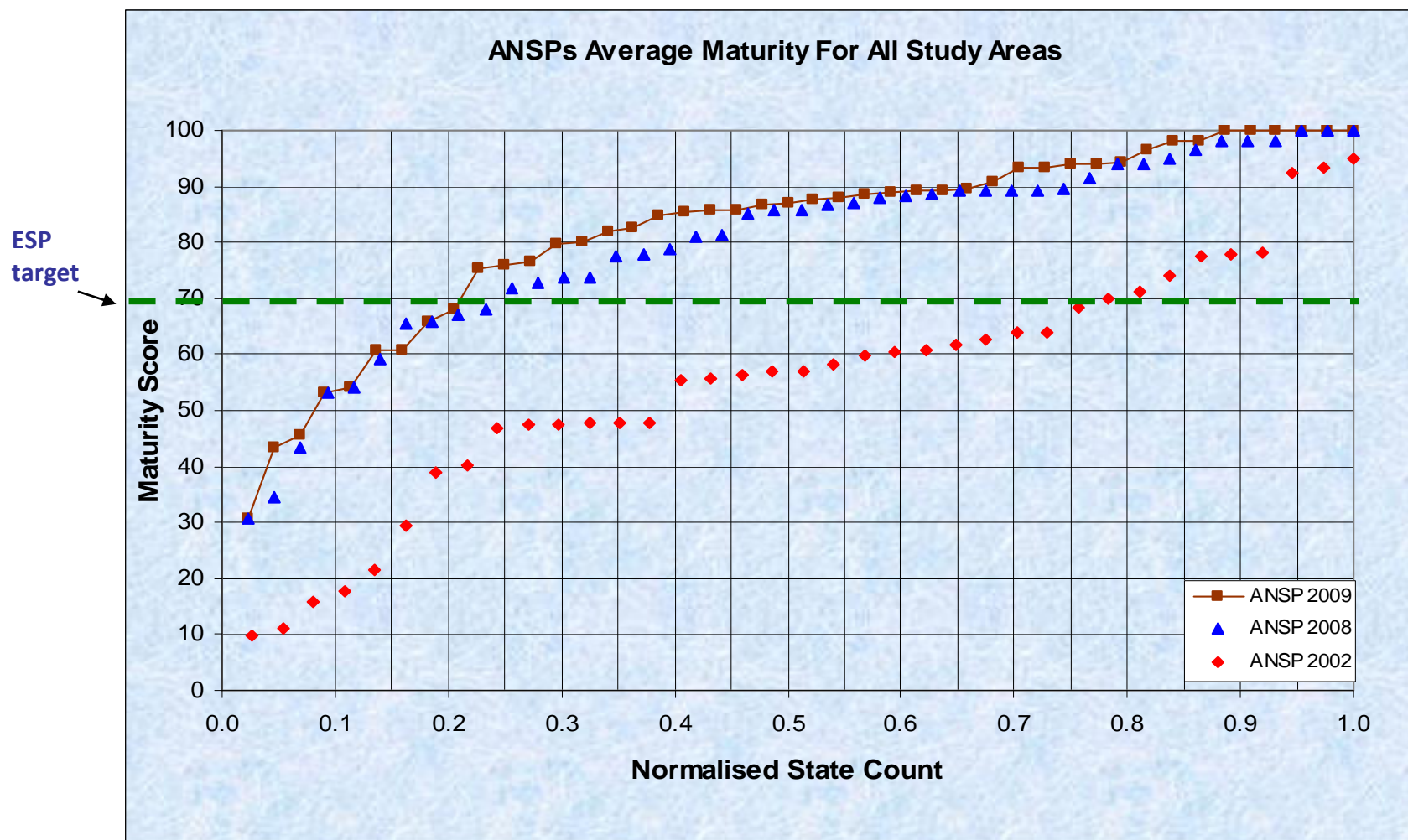

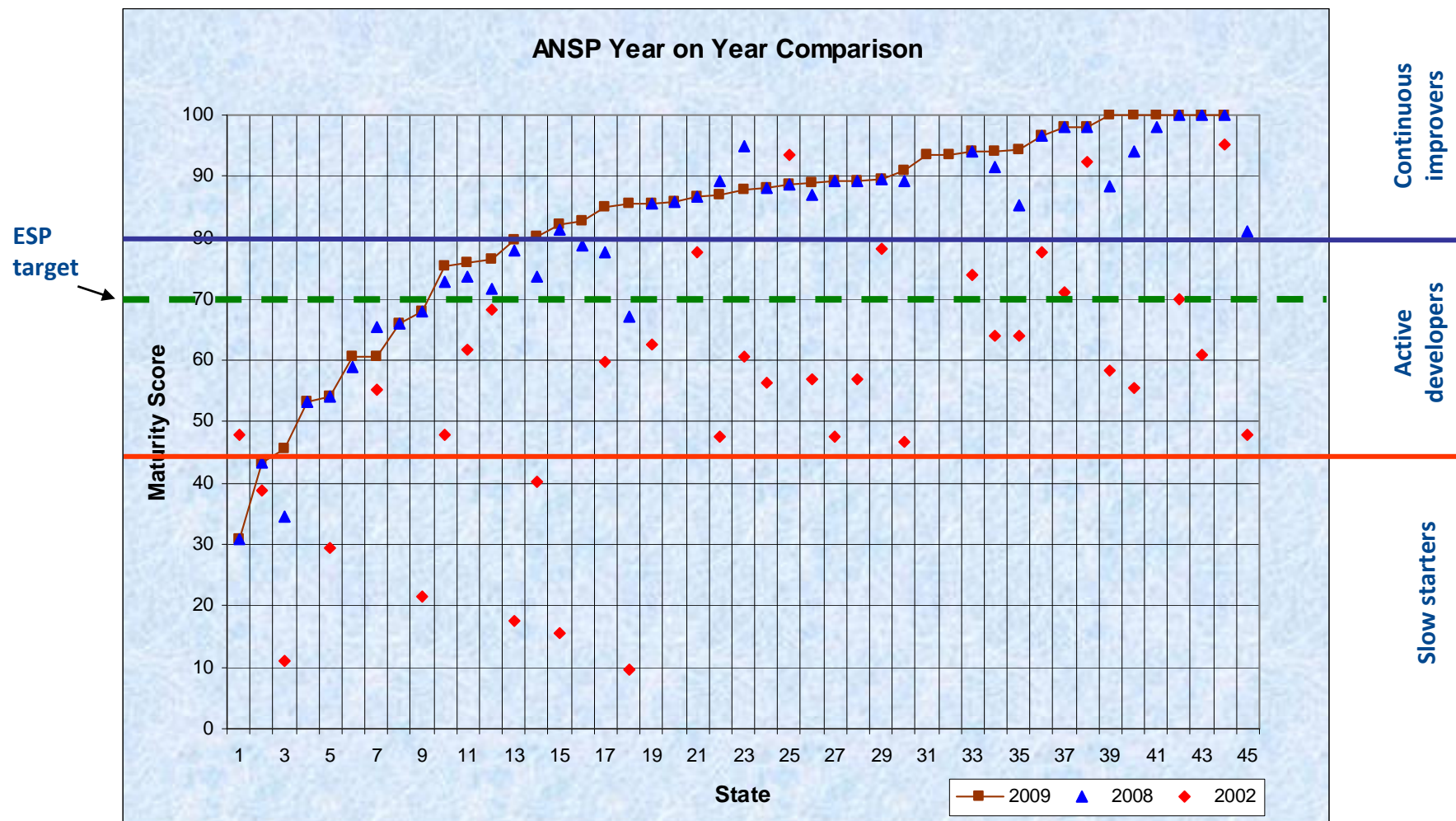

SASI became ES2 in 2010

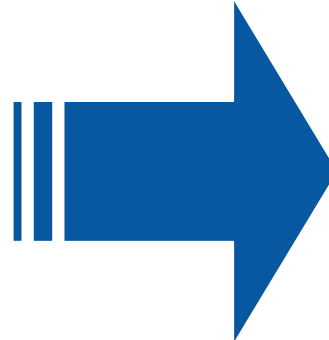
1. SMS Maturity levels have narrowed

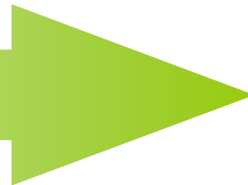

Participation in 2010

- Average of + 30 participants per session
- Average number of 12 organisations per session
- Total participation
 - Participants: + 120
 - Organisations: ~30
- **No participation of regulators although invited**

Themes and achievements in 2010

- **Pretty much classical SMS implementation subjects**
- **Overall opinion that SMS implementation is now covered (results Safety Maturity confirm) with the exception of Safety Assessment (software, quantification and evolving legislation)**
- **Need to link with the themes to be seen later in the WS – i.e. Safety Culture, Safety Intelligence, Tools (APF, RAT, ASMT) and KPIs**

Trends, constraints and options for 2011

- Strong request to address FAB safety case and FAB Safety KPIs
- Some remaining issues for SMS
 - Safety assessment/Unit Safety Case/Quantification
 - Assessment of software (ESARR6)
- Related subjects not fully completed
 - Governance
 - Cost of SMS (practical tool) and link with Safety Maturity and Safety Targets
- Budgetary constraints for all
- Should Regulators/NSAs be (more) involved or not?
 - We are advanced in a project on NSA-ANSP interface
