



- Need for another ES² WS to finalise harmonised approaches? Use ½ day in Ljubljana WS to finalise the joint position;
- FABs to share evolutions of their safety material through ECTL; Safety policy across-FABs (not for Press release);
- ECTL to put together the outcomes of this WS and further bi-lateral discussions and propose a pan-ANSP common position;
- Present and Discuss it at the joint session SRC/Safety Team ;
- Propose the approach (“means of compliance”) to EC to mitigate the risk of divergence on the FAB SC reviews – **CHECKLIST**;
- Issue a press release after the WS announcing the common view.
