- ❑ There are 3 at Level 1 and 16 at Level 2

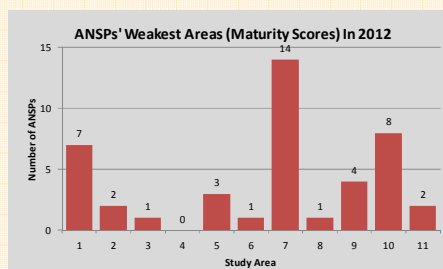




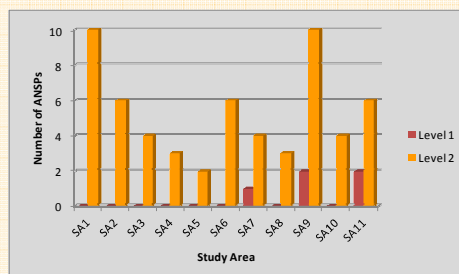

SA7: Safety Interfaces



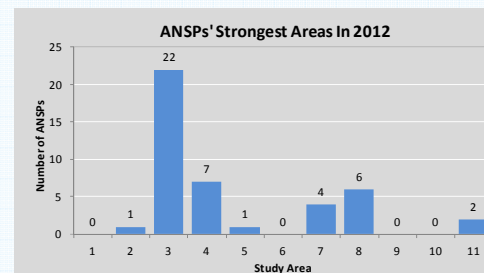

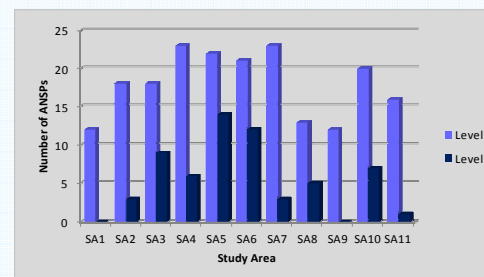
