

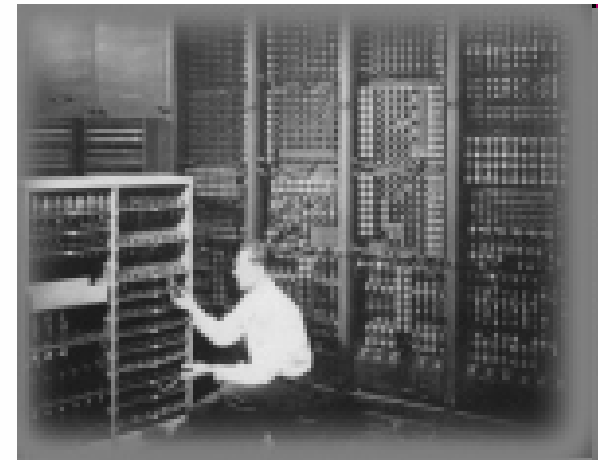

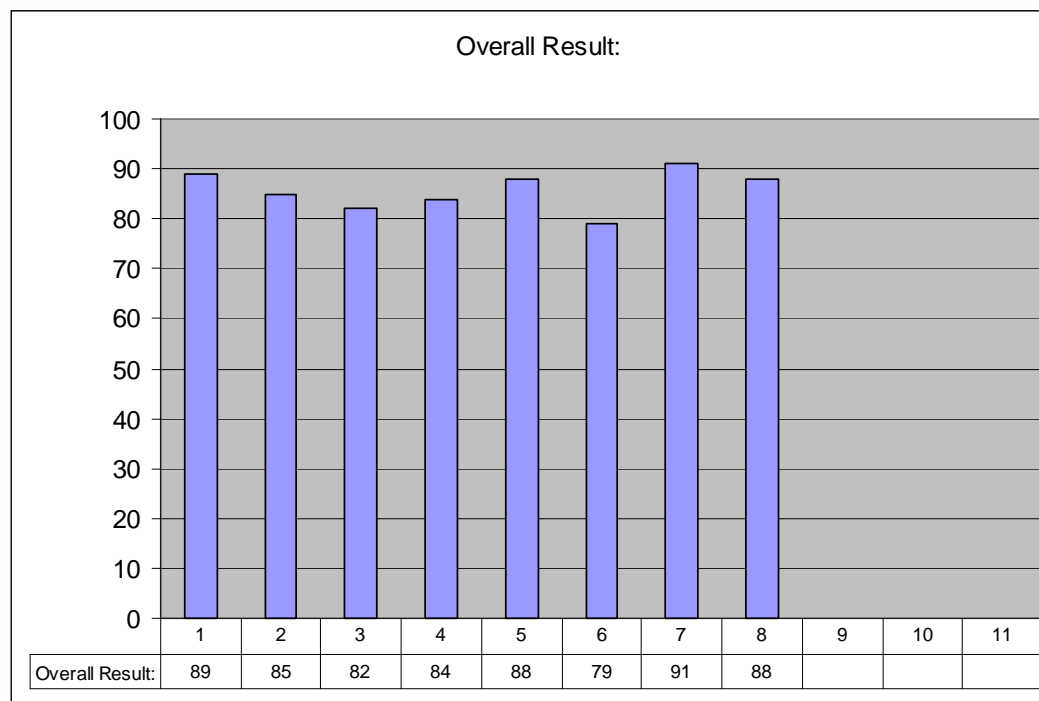

What Went Well? What Can We Improve?

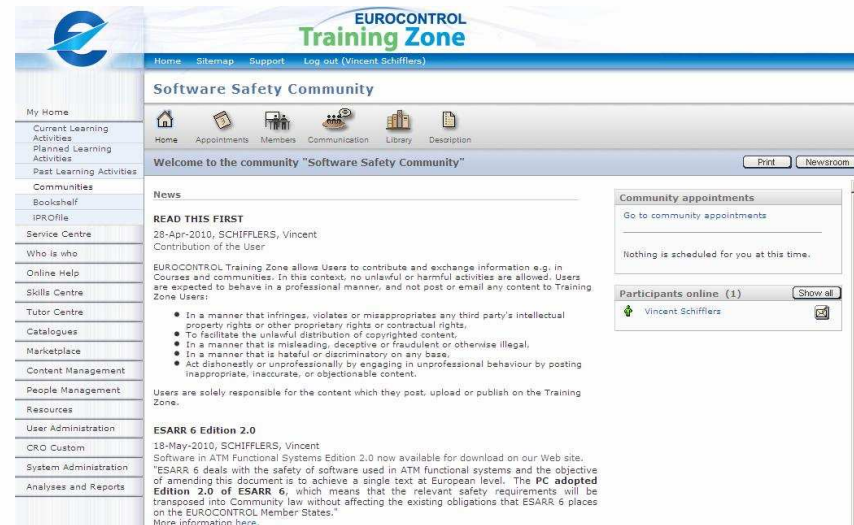
- Group mix
